The Harding County Health Council, started in 2005, is striving to provide needed medical information and services for our citizens especially our elderly residents. The Council has held two health fairs, one in April and the other one in October until COVID-19 struck. Health professionals are invited to attend. Health information, guidance, and products are available.

The county's only health clinic is open on 2 days of the week and provides ambulatory medical services, laboratory management, chronic disease management and medical referrals as needed. The county has 3 separate EMS rescue units who respond to any local emergency medical calls.

The council continues to tackle the transportation problems encountered by our elderly as they try to maintain their health, independence and quality of life.

We are also committed to assisting our county veterans to obtain needed health & behavioral assistance through the NMVA system without the additional problem of transportation.
