

# BERNALILLO COUNTY FOOD RESOURCES UPDATE

October 5, 2021

## Roadrunner Food Bank

- **Food assistance Line: Call 349-5340, M-F, 8:00-4:00**  
Or go online to the “Find Food” tab, “Food assistance near you,” enter a zip code and mile radius of food assistance. <https://www.rafb.org/find-help/find-food/>  
BUT call the individual food pantry first before going there to find out if they are open.
- **Mobile food distributions:** Families qualify if on SNAP or low-income, but no proof requested or required. One vehicle can have people from more than 1 household asking for food. Each household receives two boxes: non-perishable food box and frozen food box with TFAP food – may include milk, eggs, meat (chicken and ham).
  - **EXPO NM: Every Tuesday until further notice**, 9:30 am start time at EXPO New Mexico, 300 San Pedro Dr. NE (use Gate 3 at San Pedro and Copper).
  - **ABQ Westside: Every Friday until further notice**, 9:30 am start time at the AMC Theater off Coors & Rio Bravo, 3810 Las Estancias Way (enter via Pops Plaza and registration is in the parking lot)Masks are still required. Please clear your trunk or truck bed so food boxes can be placed there. If this is your first time at one of the drive-through food distributions, please consider **pre-registering** in advance. Pre-registration isn’t required and doesn’t guarantee a place in line, however, it helps speed up the wait times. To register visit: <https://rafb.link2feed.com/>

- Monday through Friday, 9:00 am to 11:00 am and 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm
- Photo ID for each adult and ID for each child (eg., Medicaid, birth certificate, school ID).
- **Masks required.**

## City of Albuquerque

### Health & Social Services Centers (HSSC)

- Walk-in for food boxes. Bring ID and proof of address. You do not need to call first unless you are unsure which of the 4 centers serves your address (you can call 311 to find out).
  - Monday, Wednesday & Friday, 10am - 12noon
  - Tues & Thurs, 1pm-3 pm.
- No walk-ins for anything else at these 4 centers.
- Rent and utility assistance is offered at all 4 centers. You must call the center that serves your address to find out if you are eligible and to schedule an appointment if you are.
- Clothing Bank for adults and children, only by appointment at East Central and John Marshall. Anyone in Albuquerque can call for appointment.
- Diapers and toiletries. Call the center that serves your address and ask for an appointment.

DSA is continuing to deliver meals Monday-Friday to homebound seniors (age 60+) and other homebound persons residing anywhere in Bernalillo County (including outside of city of ABQ limits). If you cannot get to a lunch site or a grocery store, you can call to request home delivered meals. These are being offered on a temporary basis to individuals for 30 days or until the City's COVID-19 emergency order ends. Calls are answered Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 4:15 pm.

Call to request a food box if you are a senior or disabled adult in New Mexico who cannot access groceries. Leave a message with your name, phone number and the city/town you live in. Your call will be returned and a team will arrange for food delivery to your home. State employees & volunteers are preparing and delivering food boxes.
