The State of NM's Dept of Health (DOH), and the New Mexico Coalition to End Homelessness (NMCEH) are working closely with shelters to maintain up to date information and provide resources to those who remain open.

COVID-19 UPDATE: The State's Department of Health (DOH) is accepting referrals from hospitals and shelters for people who are homeless and either symptomatic, tested positive for Coronavirus, or are at high risk due to vulnerability. Those referrals will be screened by the state's team and *MAY* be offered a hotel room by way of a purchase order. Again, these referrals will only be accepted from a hospital or homeless shelter.
