


R LUNA COUNTY HEALTH COUNCIL

Luna County is predominantly a rural county with an average of 8.4 persons per square mile with an estimated of 25,427.*

Access to Care




22.9% of adults over 18 have healthcare coverage in Luna County.

What have we been doing about it?

FY21: created/promoted a digital community resource directory. Produce and disseminate pocket resource guides for provider info as well as behavior health resources. The health council partners with school-based health center which has been in operation since 2017.

Underage Drinking & Drug Misuse



In Luna County 31.6% of high school students report having consumed alcohol within the last 30 days.‡

What have we been doing about it?

- Collected and disposed of unused prescription drugs at our Drug Take Back events in April and October.
- Medication drop box at the Deming Police Department has been open since 2019.
- Continue implementation of environmental strategies with the #NotinMyHouse prevention campaign.

COVID-19



Luna County has the second highest COVID-19 vaccination rates in the SW Region



What have we been doing about it?

- DOH provided drive-thru testing and vaccine events.
- In collaboration with the Luna County Emergency
 Management and the Complete Count committee we
 distributed over 1000 at home covid-19 test kits.
- Disseminate COVID-19 vaccine educational materials and promoted vaccine events.

Disease Prevention



- Utilize community health workers to reach those most vulnerable.
- Distributed 100 bags with resources and substance use education and prevention. The council also gave a presentation to 50+ parents with Help NM on opiod addiction and education.
- Partner with DOH to provide harm reduction.
- Over 1000 copies of medication safety tips distributed.
- Disseminate syringe exchange info.

Mental Health & Substance Abuse Awareness



Hosted two Annual Recovery Awareness Walk events to educate community members that substance use treatment and mental health services can enable those with mental and substance use disorders to live healthy and rewarding lives.

Capacity Building



Recipients of the New Mexico Culture of Health Initiative. This project is to increase community engagement to create health equity. Luna County Health Council has multi-sector partnerships

that play a significant role in the health of our community. The health council recently hired a health equity coordinator and is working with DOH, CHWI, and The Alliance of health councils to achieve health equity in the county and increase the health council's capacity to increase impact and reduce disparities.

HIGHLIGHTS

- The health council works in conjunction with its state and local partners to serve a vulnerable population on the US-Mexico border. The major highlight of the councils is its role in connecting community members and resources.
- Recent funding has allowed the council to partner with CHWI, NM Alliance of Health councils, and department of health to focus on health equity- ensuring all Luna county residents has the ability to prosper. The council is working to ensure everyone is treated justly according to their circumstances.
- The council launched a successful vaccine equity plan which included many non-profit groups as well as The Deming Public Schools and Mimbres Memorial Hospital.
- The council has recently partnered with the DOH Office of Border Health to increase their capacity and greater serve their community.
